

Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent, you play a special role in the development of your daughter or son, and of his/her teammates. Your encouragement and good example will do more to ensure good sportsmanship and self-discipline than any other influence.

I therefore agree that:

- I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- I will refrain from coaching my child and other players from the sidelines, thereby respecting the responsibilities I have placed on the coach.
- I will refrain from verbal abuse, unsportsmanlike and disruptive use of noisemakers, intimidate, or physical altercation.
- I will remember that the game is for the children NOT for the adults.
- I will do my best to make sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will use only positive encouragement to either team from the sidelines.
- I will accept the decisions of the officials, coaches, and Crown Sports Center administrators without argument or derogatory comments.
- I will conduct myself with dignity and encourage the same behavior from others. Crown Sports Center will not tolerate conduct that is detrimental to the sport. Such negative conduct includes: Vulgarity by coaches, players or parents, harassment of officials, coaches or player; verbal abuse, threat or physical violence toward anyone before, during or after the game; and taunting of opposing players, coaches and parents.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or Crown administrator.
- Written warning.
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file.
- Game forfeiture through the official or Crown administrator.
- Parental season suspension.
- Parental facility suspension

Coaches Code of Conduct

Each coach participating in an activity at Crown Sports Center will agree that his/her conduct is that of a lady or gentleman, demonstrating at all times the highest level of sportsmanship and fair play. To satisfactorily meet responsibilities, every coach is expected to comply with the rules of the Coach's Code of Conduct below.

1. Know the rules of the activity or sports that you are coaching and abide by them.
2. Instruct team members in the rules of the game and motivate each player to complete according to the rules at all times.
3. Respect the game officials and refrain from questioning their decision or from addressing them in a loud, disrespectful, or abusive manner.
4. Ensure that your players and spectators follow all building and facility rules and Regulations at and during Crown Sports Center activities.
5. Respect the coaches and players of the opposing team both during the play of the game and at its conclusion, win or lose.
6. Teach each player, especially through personal example, to be humble and generous in victory and proud and courteous in defeat.
7. Never smoke or use tobacco products in front of players during any Crown Sports Center sponsored activity, including but not limited to, practices and games.
8. Realize, accept, and practice the principle that a team's reputation is built not only on its playing ability, but also on its sportsmanship and courtesy.
